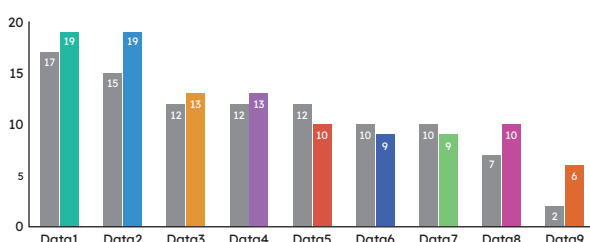

LEVEL 1, 1+ Lv.1 Lv.1+ • Sensory Perception : Exploration level, simple constructions • Sensory Execution : Clumsy hand manipulation • Assistance: Requires a lot of help LEVEL 2, 2+ Lv.2 Lv.2+ • Sensory Perception : Free vertical & horizontal combinations • Sensory Execution : Attempts fine motor manipulation • Assistance: Requires some appropriate assistance LEVEL 3, 3+ Lv.3 Lv.3+ • Sensory Perception : Able to freely combine various shapes • Sensory Execution : Skilled hand manipulation • Assistance: Can manage independently or with minimal help
